Communication & Language



Listening, Attention and Understanding

Maths

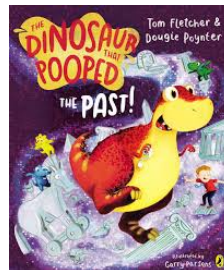


Number
