

Challenge 1— Maths

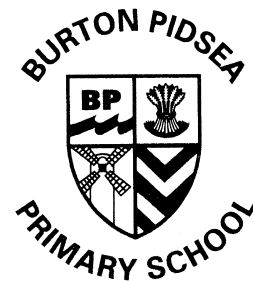
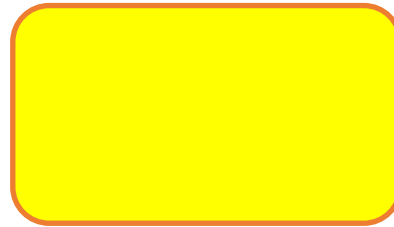
This half term we are learning about time. Become a **Time Detective** and investigate how time is used in your daily life.

For each activity:

- Write the time it started.
 - Write the time it ended.
- Calculate how long the activity lasted.



Challenge 2— History

The Maya were skilled mathematicians, astronomers, architects and farmers. For this homework task, choose **one Maya achievement** that interests you and become an expert!

Your task:

Create a poster, leaflet, PowerPoint, model or fact file that explains:

- What the achievement was.
 - Why it was important to the Maya people.
 - How it helped Maya society.
 - Whether it has influenced life today.
- At least **five interesting facts** about your chosen achievement.

Challenge 3— Art

Create an illustration inspired by your favourite scene, character or setting from a book you have enjoyed reading. Use colour, detail and creativity to bring your chosen part of the story to life and be ready to explain why you selected it.
